NAPLAN YEAR 3 AND YEAR 5 REPORTS

Parents and carers will have received the 2023 NAPLAN report for your child/ren, the first of a new, national system. The report is a snapshot in time – 16 weeks ago, in fact, so please refer to these in the context of your child's Semester One school report and the judgement from your class teacher/s.

NAPLAN is an ok system to measure a school's overall performance, which we cross-match and reference against many school-based and contextual factors. Roebuck Primary School's high standards and expectations are reflected in these strong NAPLAN results.

CULTURAL RESPONSIVE EXPERIENCE

The Sunday prior to returning to on-site work, staff, School Board members, Cluster Principals', Collegiate Principal, and several students participated in an on-Country experience at Lullumb, on the east side of the peninsular at Djardinjin.

*\$650 is the expected total cost inclusive of all activities, accommodation, transport and food for a five day camp. Parent fundraising has historically reduced the contribution to approximately \$300 per student. This amount per child per annum is therefore dependent and directly related to the effort and energy of the fundraising.

Prior to camp, payment plans may be negotiated with the Principal.

Payment will be requested during the school year when costs and participation by students is confirmed.

Please note that transport costs related to any excursion are non-refundable.

We are now taking enrolments for Kindy 2024. If your child is turning 4 on or prior to 30 June 2023, please call in to the office to collect an enrolment form.

As Pre-Primary is the first year of compulsory schooling, it is also a requirement to re-enrol into Pre-Primary. *Attending our Kindy program does not enrol you into a Pre-Primary class.*

Please call into the office to complete the enrolment process. You will need to bring along a current proof of residence and an up-to-date Medicare Immunisation History Statement.

DOGS ON SITE



It is timely that we remind parents / carers that whilst dogs are a much-loved member of many families, to ensure the safety of all, dogs are not to be brought onto the school grounds between the hours of 7.30 am - 2.30 pm, even on a leash. Many children do not know how to interact with the more robust and energetic dogs, and as we have had several incidences of children becoming scared because of these interactions, we need to ensure we keep all safe.

Blaze, our wellbeing dog is introducing herself to the students and there are mini-lessons on how to interact and engage with a dog. Blaze, is temperament assessed by a vet and Blaze continues to have training to engage in a school environment.

SPACETALK-OUTREACH: SMS

Our school messaging service MGM—Outreach was recently rebranded as **Spacetalk—Outreach**. This service is a great way for staff to communicate effectively with parents for attendance and emergency matters.

While this rebranding will have no impact on parents and carers it is a good opportunity to remind everyone that this service is <u>not monitored</u>.

What are the requirements for notification of student absences?

It is a legal requirement that parents contact the school regarding any student absences or reasons for lateness. If an explanation for the absence has been provided prior to 8:30 each morning, then parents will not receive an SMS.

Parents need to be aware that this system is an additional absence follow up service only. There will be times when parents may not receive a text message due to technical issues. In cases where you are concerned about your child's attendance, please contact the school directly.
