Parent Information

Pre-Primary to Year One Transition

Starting Year One is an exciting time for your child. The Year One program is a little different to Kindergarten and Pre-Primary as your child grows and becomes more independent.

The following information is to assist you in preparing your child for Year One.

What Your Child Needs to Bring

- A large school bag that will hold school work, a lunch box, water bottle, change of clothes and other items to be taken home.
- Children are required to wear closed in shoes or sandals with a heel strap. This ensures their safety when they are running around and doing Physical Education lessons. Children are not allowed to take their shoes off during the day unless requested to by the teacher for a specific lesson. In Year One, children are **not to wear thongs** to school.
- A healthy snack for recess and a nutritional lunch. Please ensure that food is stored in containers that children can open independently. Cooler bags are unnecessary as lunchboxes are stored in the fridge. **Please put your child's morning tea and lunch in separate containers.**
- A water bottle, clearly labelled.
- A wide brimmed or bucket style school hat. Roebuck Primary School supports the 'No Hat, No Play SunSmart Policy'.
- Please **label** all stationery items.

Developing Independence

Please help your child to develop their independence by teaching them to:

- Take care of their belongings.
- Carry and unpack their school bag.
- Open lunch containers themselves.
- Know the difference between their recess and their lunch items.
- Put on their shoes.

School Starts

School starts at 8.00am. Classroom doors open at 7.45am. If children arrive before 7.45am, they are to leave their bags outside their classroom and wait in the under covered area, supervised by a teacher, until 7.45am when the classrooms are open.

School finishes at 2.00pm.

Recess and Lunch

Recess: 10.00am -10.20am

Lunch: 12.20pm-12.50pm

Year One children have an allocated play area during break times. There will be duty teachers supervising the Year One play area.



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Specialist Classes

Year One students will be taught by specialist teachers. Specialist classes run for an hour each week in the following programs:

- Science
- Physical Education
- Music
- Indonesian
