

Roebuck Primary School Uniform Policy

Our school dress code plays an important role in promoting a positive image of the school and creating a sense of identity and supports our focus of a safe and inclusive school environment.

Our School Uniform Policy has been developed in consultation with, and endorsed by, the Roebuck Primary School Board.

***School Bottoms**

Boys and girls are required to wear shorts, skirts or skorts that come to **at least** mid-thigh and are plain black in colour. A small logo or emblem is permitted.

Headwear

All students must wear a maroon broad-brimmed hat or maroon bucket hat as part of the school uniform. **No caps are allowed.** All children need a hat for physical education lessons, outdoor play, and for recess and lunch. As we have a 'no hat, stay in the shade' rule for recess and lunchtime, students without an appropriate school hat will need to remain in the undercover areas.

This broad brimmed hat policy is fully supported by the Cancer Council as an effective means of protecting students from the harmful effects of over exposure to UV rays. Please support this policy in the interests of your child's long-term health. Please label your child's hat, as these are taken with the child throughout the day and can be easily misplaced.

Footwear

In Year 1 to Year 6, students are required to wear sensible, closed-in shoes to school. Appropriate footwear includes runners/joggers or sandals with a back strap.

Crocs, thongs, slip-on sandals and roller blade shoes are not permitted at school. Should a medical condition or injury necessitate the wearing of any of these kinds of footwear, a written note or medical certificate needs to be provided to the child's classroom teacher, please.

In Kindergarten and Pre-Primary, students have the option to take their shoes off during the school day.

Hair

For hygiene and safety, long hair needs to be tied up at school. Long hair must be tied back as a preventative measure in avoiding/containing the spread of headlice at school. Long hair is considered a length that touches the child's shoulders or shirt collar and longer, or hangs below their eyes. This applies to both girls and boys at our school.

Jewellery

Children with pierced ears can come to school wearing small sleepers or studs. Other jewellery may pose a catching hazard and are not to be worn at school. For example, a large neck chain and/or dangly earrings. Students are permitted to wear a watch to school, but Smart Watches need to be turned on to Flight Mode during school hours. Jewellery, such as bangles, rings and bracelets, can become a distraction at school and need to remain at home.

Uniform Purchase

Roebuck Primary School maroon shirts and maroon broad-brimmed and bucket hats can be purchased from Totally Workwear Broome.

Roebuck Primary School faction shirts can be purchased from our P&C. The school P&C also run a second-hand uniform shop intermittently during the year, and this is promoted through the school's Facebook page. Plain black shorts, skirts, skirts and trousers are often stocked at Best and Less and Kmart for purchase.
